

She returned to Disney in 2013 to become a contract facilitator for Disney Institute. She facilitated professional development classes and custom programs in both French and English. Valerie's approach is easy to understand, relatable and memorable. Her audience members can discover tools and tactics that are easy to implement so they can make an impact in their organizations.



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
